1. Who we are

The Carmarthen County BA Website is a privately owned, privately run Website which exists to serve the needs of Carmarthen County Bowling Association.

2. How we use the personal details

Data: On this Carmarthen County BA Website, there is NO data gathering, therefore NO data can be stored or passed on to others. The only data existing on this Web-Site is associated to contributors who use designated pages within this site for the purpose of keeping bowlers informed of tournaments, and team selection. Each of the contributors has given written permission for their data to be used.

Photographs: When a photograph is used on this web-site, for example, of an Officer, or a Tournament Winner or Winners, such photographs will only be displayed with the permission of the individual or individuals who appear within the photograph.

Closed Season Gallery: This Web-Site uses a 'Gallery' of bowlers photographs during the 'closed season'. Because every Gallery photographs used is free of identifying names, there is no data that requires protection.
